Clearviews Glass French Balcony Installation Instructions

- 1. Line up bottom track to be horizontally center with the window opening.
- 2. Line up bottom track vertically to allow the access to the glazing bead from the inside.
- 3. When properly lined up fasten the bottom track brackets firmly to the wall. (use a level to make sure you are horizontally level)
- 4. Measure the correct height of the handrail position (Use the Clearviews Section Drawing in the downloads section)
- 5. Center the handrail to be center with window/equal overlap on the two sides.
- 6. When properly lined up fasten the handrail firmly to the wall through the brackets
- 7. Remove bottom glazing bead if in place.
- 8. Place two spacers on the bottom track for each glass and use a dab of silicone to hold them in place.
- 9. Remove any stickers/writing/spacers that are stuck on the glass.
- 10. Put the glass panes in place by inserting them into the slot in the handrail and lowering them onto the spacers.
- 11. Replace the glazing bead in the bottom rail.
- 12. Line the glass panes up in position so that they are spaced correctly between each other/ wall etc.
- 13. Insert the 1/8" (3mm) rubber gasket in the bottom track between the glass and the glazing bead. (using soap water can ease the process)
- 14. Insert the two 1/8" (3mm) rubber gaskets on both sides of the handrail. (using soap water can ease the process)
- 15. Trim off excess rubber.
